Each IEP has at least three pages: Page 1 is the information about your child.; Page 2 is the list of the subjects/courses and formal assessments in your child's records.; Page 3 indicates the accommodations your child needs to be successful in the program. Only accommodations that are different than those used by other students in the class are listed.
